

# 2022 Junior Cup

## Overview

This league is for more advanced players who have some experience playing the game of golf. For example, a middle school team or PGA Jr. League. The season will consist of an in-house “regular season”, followed by a 2-3 week “playoffs”. Practices will be focused on improvement, competition, and teamwork. The mission for the kids will be to win the regular season as an individual, then win the playoffs as part of a team.

## Regular Season

This league will run for about 4-5 weeks consisting of a weekly practice, and a weekly tournament. Points will be accumulated based on finishing position of each tournament. Players will also be separated into divisions by ages as necessary.

## Post Season

The post-season will resemble a “Ryder Cup” format made up of 2 teams. How these teams will be created is TBD.

## When

The season will begin mid to late June, with the post season running into August. If there are times/days that work well or don't work well, please communicate those with Timothy.

## Where

All practices and tournaments will be held at Old Capital Golf Course.

## Who

4<sup>th</sup> thru 8<sup>th</sup> grade – both boys and girls.

This league is for anyone who has not yet played golf in high school. This means an 8<sup>th</sup> grader who is about to enroll in high school is eligible. Anyone older would be ineligible. Also, if your son or daughter is younger than 4<sup>th</sup> grade, but believe he/she is ready for this level, please contact Timothy to discuss. Exceptions may be made.

## Cost

The cost will be \$250 per player. Payments can be completed at the first day of practice. Check, cash, or Venmo is acceptable.
